### Day 1: Sunday

We’ll meet you at Los Cabos International Airport and bring you to *Pacific Provider* for an early afternoon embarkation. After touring your stateroom, you’ll get an introduction to the ship and a safety briefing, and we’ll be ready to depart around 3pm. We’ll pass the famous El Arco (The Arch) at Land’s End, cruising until we drop anchor near Cabo Pulmo, a protected marine reserve, where you can kayak, swim or have one of our tenders take you ashore. After an incredible dinner, we’ll relax with a cocktail, watch the sun set and get to know our fellow adventurers.



### Day 2: Monday

Cruising north, we’ll skirt the rugged coast of Punta Arena, sighting its signature lighthouse and small town of Los Barriles, where our tenders can ferry you to amazing beaches and nearly limitless options for land and water fun. The area is also prime roosterfish habitat—considered among the world’s most unique and exciting gamefish, which can reach 100 lbs. of muscle and bad attitude.

### Day 3: Tuesday

This morning, pursue dorado, yellowtail, golden grouper and other local game fish, or set off to sight the many whales and dolphins inhabiting these waters. Following lunch, your options span a range of activities on both land and sea—do everything, or nothing at all. At day's end, we'll gather around a campfire on the beach for dinner, followed by fresh-made desserts and cocktails under a star-strewn sky.

### Day 4: Wednesday

After breakfast, we'll explore uninhabited Isla Cerralvo—Jacques Cousteau island—surrounded by rich waters renowned for marlin, swordfish and other prize catches. Later, we'll continue north, searching out pods of whales and dolphins as we make our way to Isla Espiritu Santo.



### Day 5: Thursday

This morning, we'll explore Isla Espiritu Santo and its stunningly clear waters. You can walk the white sands of Ensenada Grande, ranked one of the world's top 12 beaches, wonder at the stark beauty of Caleta Candelero or hike to a freshwater spring. Or take one of our four tenders to Los Islotes, where you can swim with sea lions.



### Days 6-7: Friday & Saturday

Wake to a fresh breakfast before exploring Playa Balandra, where you can beachcomb, hike, snorkel, or go stand-up paddle boarding. After lunch, we'll swim with whale sharks, which were recently added to the endangered species list. That evening, over cocktails and fish tales, we'll enjoy a slideshow of our week's activities—adventures shared with new friends. After a last shipboard breakfast on Saturday morning, we'll transfer you to the airport for your flight home.
