

Deposit, Refund and Cancellation Policies:

We are in the business of providing a luxury adventure cruise ship with an intimate travel experience operating with a maximum of 12 passengers on-board. For this reason, if you reserve with Offshore Outpost and must later cancel, it can have a significant impact on our operations. Additionally, Offshore Outpost cannot guarantee weather conditions or control acts of nature that could result in the cancellation of a trip. As such, a schedule of required passenger deposits and payments, as well as our refund and cancellation policy are noted below:

- Non-refundable \$1,500 deposit per person due within 3 business days to hold your reserved space
- Remaining balance of the trip purchase price is due 120 days in advance of the trip departure date
 - Total trip purchase price is 50% refundable up to 90 days prior to trip departure date
- At 89 days prior to the trip departure date, the full trip purchase price is non-refundable, unless we have to cancel your trip due to unforeseen circumstances (e.g. weather).
- For trips booked within 1 to 90 days of the trip departure date, full trip purchase price is due within 3 business days of booking the trip

For the reasons noted above, we *highly recommend* our passengers obtain travel insurance to protect against losses and fees in the event your travel plans change.

Trips that are canceled due to a Company decision are subject to a full refund.

Tips for Crew

Tips for our crew are not included in the price of the trip. Tipping is purely at the guest's discretion and should be determined based on your satisfaction with the trip; however, guests generally tip 10% of the non-discounted trip price to reward the crew for their hard work during your trip. This is only a recommendation. Tips should be given to the Captain the form of cash or check. 100% of the tip amount is shared by our crew. We cannot accept credit cards for crew tips. Our crew generally consists of eight persons: Captain, 1st Mate, Engineer, Chef, 2 Stewards and 2 Deckhands.

Travel & Medical Insurance

Guests should check their medical coverage to ensure it is adequate to cover the risks associated with an adventure cruise trip. We also highly recommend protecting your trip from unexpected events and medical emergencies through the purchase of travel, trip interruption and evacuation insurance. Prices for these types of coverages vary dependent upon the type and amount of coverage; however, medical evacuations can be very costly. While we strive to provide the safest cruising environment possible, there are inherent risks associated with adventure travel; therefore, all passengers are required to sign our **Guest Ticket Contract** prior to embarking on the trip, acknowledging the guest is aware of these risks. You should also consider insuring your luggage, as Offshore Outpost does not accept responsibility for lost, damaged or delayed personal property. As noted in our **Deposit**, **Refund and Cancellation Policies**, we cannot refund your trip cost with 89 days of your trip date, unless your trip is cancelled by our company for unforeseen circumstances.
