Mexico Recommended Packing List

Baja California and the Sea of Cortez has ideal cruising weather throughout the year. While average annual rainfall in this area is only approximately 7", primarily in the summer months, rain showers can occur throughout the year; therefore, we recommend our guests bring a light waterproof jacket or windbreaker to ensure your comfort on the journey of a lifetime. Attire on board our vessel is casual.

During our cruising months of November to March, the average temperature is around 75 degrees Fahrenheit during the daytime, nights can dip as low as the 50's. The coolest months are in the winter, with average temperatures around 65 degrees Fahrenheit. The water temperature in our area of operation averages between 65 and 70 degrees Fahrenheit.

North American outlets are provided on board the ship, so we recommend bringing an adapter if you are coming from a country outside of the United States.

We recommend you pack in soft sided luggage, such as duffel bags, to assist in loading and unloading your luggage from the ship.

We provide Gilchrist & Soames toiletries (shampoo, conditioner, shower gel, body lotion) onboard the ship. If you prefer a different brand, please pack accordingly.

Please remember to bring your Passport, Driver's License, and travel documents

- Lightweight long pants and shirts (SPF/sun protection clothing due to exposure to sun)

- Sports bras for activities
- Multiple swimsuits for ocean swimming and onboard jacuzzi
